**ORDER GRANTING PLIANITFF'S MOTION FOR  
INTERLOCUTORY INJUNCTION**


This matter is before the Court on the Motion of the Plaintiff, Tea Party Patriots, Inc. ("TPP"), an interlocutory injunction against Defendant Amy Kremer. The Plaintiff appeared, with counsel, at a hearing on the Motion on November 10, 2009. The Defendant did not appear. After due consideration of Plaintiff's Motion, brief in support, and supporting affidavit and exhibits, as well as evidence, the Court orders as follows:

Plaintiff's Motion for Interlocutory Injunction is GRANTED. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 9-11-65(b)(2), Plaintiff's attorney has certified to the Court, in writing, the efforts which have been made to give notice to Defendant of this Motion and this hearing, and Defendant has notified the Court that she received notice of the hearing. Until further order of this Court, Defendant, her agents, employees, attorneys, and those persons acting in concert with Defendant or at her direction, are enjoined and restrained as follows:

- (1) Defendant shall not interfere in any way with TPP's exercise of control or use of its intellectual property, including the Mark and the Websites;
- (2) Defendant shall return administrative control of the Websites and the Constant Contact account and mailing list/database to TPP;
- (3) Defendant shall not hold herself out as having any position with TPP or as speaking on behalf of TPP in any way;
- (4) Defendant shall not use TPP's name or any of its Websites as part of her title or signature block;
- (5) Defendant shall not make any public disclosures regarding the proceedings of TPP's Board of Directors without the Board's consent; and
- (6) Defendant shall not use TPP's mailing lists, e-mail lists, or databases for any purpose.

The Court will hold a hearing on Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Injunction in this matter on December 10, 2009 at 8:30 a.m.


